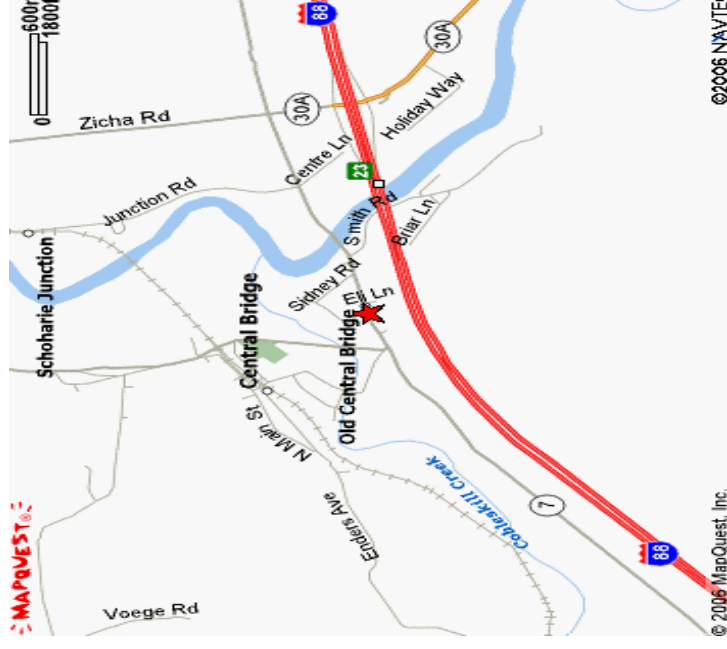

DIRECTIONS TO LOCUST PARK CAMPGROUND

FROM THE SOUTH: NYS Thruway north and west to Exit 25A, I-88 west to Exit 23, to Route 7 west; half a mile on the left.
FROM THE NORTH: Northway south to Exit 1W, NYS Thruway (I-90) west to Exit 25A, I-88 west to Exit 23, Route 7 west, half mile on the left.
FROM THE EAST: Mass Turnpike west to NYS Thruway (I-87) north to NYS Thruway (I-90) west to Exit 25A, I-88 west to Exit 23, Route 7 west, half a mile on the left.
FROM THE WEST: NYS Thruway east to Exit 29, Route 162 south to Sloansville, Route 30A south to Central Bridge, east on Route 7; approximately 500 yards on your right.
